Computer Services

- □ SCM computer account
 - Username is the same as your *Electronic ID (EID)* offered by Computing Services Centre (CSC) e.g. chantm1
 - o Change your initial password at the first logon in any SCMLAB computers
 - Default initial password is in following format:
 - The *first 2 characters from your surname* with the first character as uppercase letter and the second character as lowercase letter + *last 6 digits of your Student ID* (e.g., *Ch234567* for student "CHAN Tai-man" with Student ID is 51234567)
 - New password must be a <u>strong</u> password with at least 8 characters (i.e., a combination of letters and alphanumerics with as least 1 uppercase letter and <u>does not</u> contain your full name or your account username)
 - o Logon domain is **SCMLAB** and it is used for user login at both PC and Mac platforms
 - o This SCM computer account password must be changed every 6 months according to the University-Wide password policy. (You can change your SCM password here: https://sprwp.scm.cityu.edu.hk/)
- Network drives
 - o **Drive U:** for permanent Home network storage (4GB)
 - Secure remote connection: You can connect your Home network storage from your PC/Mac at home by using FTPS to connect to the SWEB server
 - Your personal web page URL is http://sweb.cityu.edu.hk /<account_name>/HTML_filename by placing HTML documents under U:\public_html
 - e.g. http://sweb.cityu.edu.hk/chantm1/index.html
 - W:\Public for temporary common share space (Weekly Cleanup at every Saturdays 23:00)
